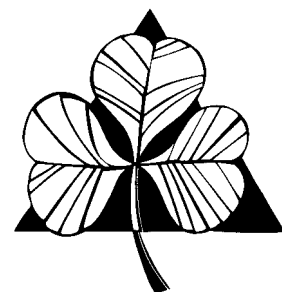

Steadfast Love - The Most Holy Trinity

We have been baptizing children and adults in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit since the earliest days of the church. But the reality of a God who is three and one at the same time is a mystery we are still trying to unfold. The names we use tell us something of the intimate inner relationship with God. Phrases like, "lover, beloved and love itself," "source, wellspring and fountain of living water," or "creator, redeemer and sustainer of the world" try to capture something of the unity and the complexity. We celebrate the generative and familial aspects of Father, Son and Spirit. Symbols like three-leaf clovers and triangles provide visual cues for reflection, and yet we struggle to understand the depths of the mystery.



In today's liturgy we are given a story, a commission and a letter. God reveals his law of love that we might enter into a deep and eternal relationship with the God who loved us into being. Jesus, God's self-giving Word made human, comes in love to the world, and sends his disciples forth to proclaim God's love to the ends of the earth. Paul writes of the love of God that manifests itself in the way the members of the Christian community love and are related to one another. In the end, we are left with the gift, that is, the grace of Jesus Christ, the love of God and the communion of the Holy Spirit; each of them drawing us closer to one another and to the mystery that is God.

May we sing praise to the life-giving Trinity and reflect the love and unity of the Trinity in our lives.

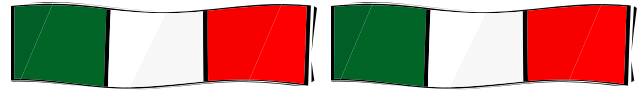
