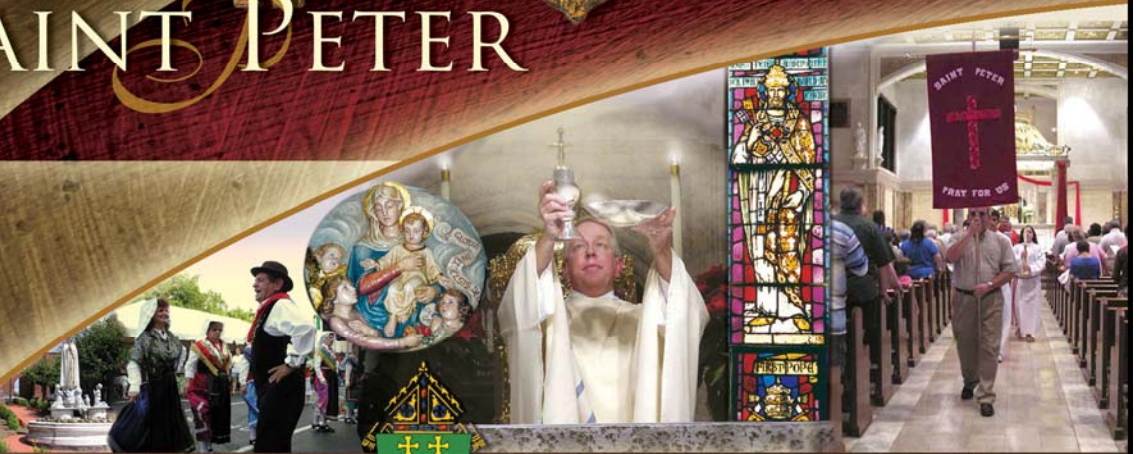
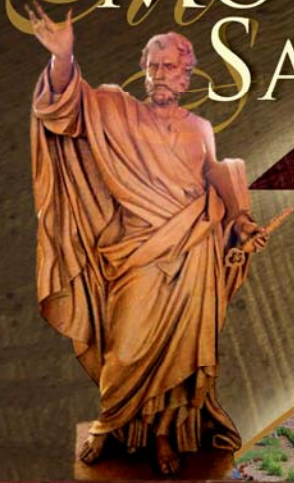

The Body of Christ

If, then, you wish to understand the Body of Christ, listen to the apostle as he says to the faithful: "You are the Body of Christ and his members, your mystery has been placed on the Lord's table, you receive your mystery." You reply "Amen!" to that which you are, and by replying you consent. For you hear "The Body of Christ" and you reply "Amen!" Be a member of the Body of Christ so that your "Amen" may be true.

The community that celebrates the Eucharist must ask itself if it is a real manifestation of the Body of Christ, and whether its sharing in the Eucharist is reflected in a just sharing of the gifts of the earth, or whether some are deprived of the means of life because others hoard the world's goods for their own advantage.

Eucharistic participation must lead first to a new social vision, then to a critique of our existing society in light of that vision, and finally, to advocacy for the poor and disadvantaged members of society and to societal change. To receive the Body and Blood of Christ is to become an active member of the Body of Christ that is blessed and broken for the life of the world.



Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

This Friday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart. This feast celebrates not an event, but the love of God manifested in the heart of Jesus. Devotion to the Sacred Heart grew throughout the Middle Ages and reached its climax with the visions of Saint Margaret Mary Alcoque. As we celebrate God's boundless love, may we imitate God's compassion and gentleness.

Pastoral Council

The June meeting of Pastoral Council was held on June 1 and began with a prayer in honor of the Holy Spirit. New members (Karen Frederick, Linda Henkel, Jennifer Lombardo, Jim Matta, and Ted Opalka) were welcomed to the council.



Updates were shared on the recent Diocesan Lenten Appeal and Youth Ministry. Upcoming work with Habitat for Humanity and the July production of *Children of Eden* are wonderful ways for the youth of Mt. St. Peter to live and practice their faith.

Maria Tallarico reported on a recent meeting of Faith in Action, a United Way project that is looking to expand into New Kensington. The program is currently active in Lower Burrell and 4 other areas of Westmoreland County. The program is designed in partnership with business, nonprofit, and interfaith community leaders to enhance the quality of life for citizens 60 years and older. Some examples of the services they hope to provide in New Kensington include appointment escort, minor repairs, caregiver relief, errands, referral assistance and supportive visits.

Leadership roles within Pastoral Council were discerned. Suzette Venturini will serve as Recorder, Maria Tallarico as Facilitator, Karen Frederick as Convener, and Linda Henkel, Jen Lombardo, Ted Opalka, and Jim Palochik will be Prayer Leaders.

The upcoming Diocesan Capital Campaign, its goals and structure were reviewed. The Campaign here at Mt. St. Peter will run from August through December. Council Members Jen Lombardo and Jim Matta will be part of the Steering Committee. As the committee meets, timelines and a case statement will be developed. Recommendations will be shared with members of Pastoral and Finance Councils, then presented to the Parish.

The US Conference of Catholic Bishops has recommended the use of *Go and Make Disciples*, a strategy for Catholic evangelization within the US. Council members will be studying this document in the months ahead to determine how we at Mt. St. Peter's can bring the Good News of Jesus into all our human situations. With evangelization comes changed lives and changed worlds - holiness, justice, spirituality, and peace result.

The meeting concluded with prayer for a renewal of the seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit in our hearts.

Youth Ministry

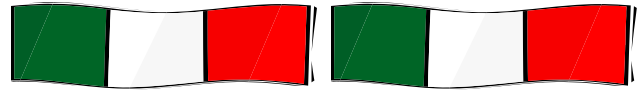
