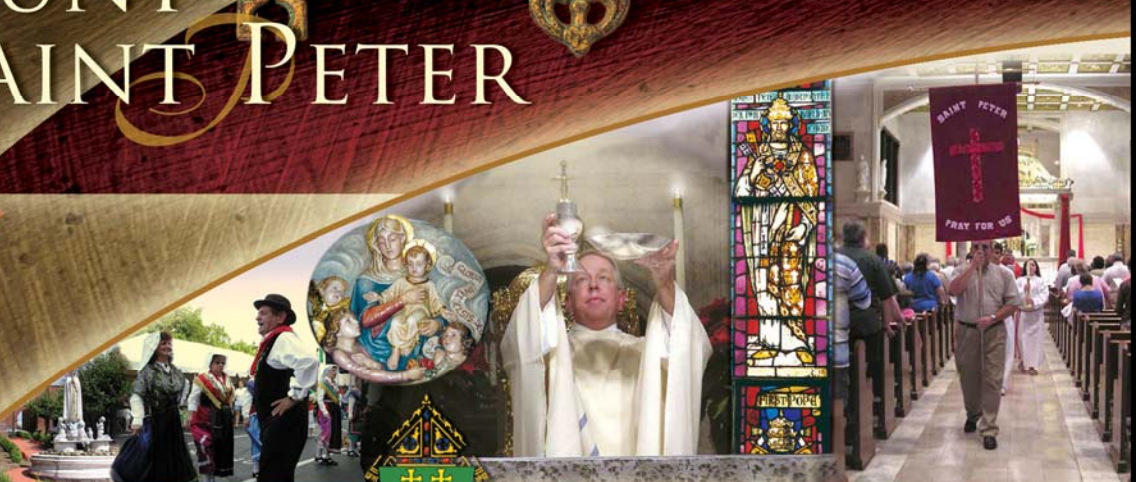
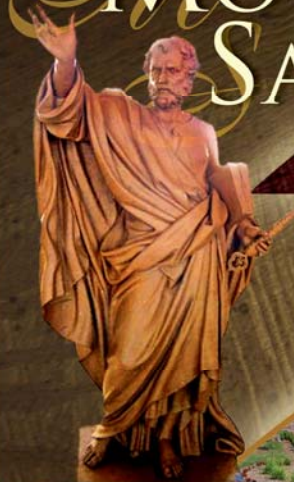

15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Last weekend, we heard how unrewarding a prophet's life can be. The ministry of Ezekiel and Jesus both testified to this.

In today's liturgy, we have bad news once again. In the first reading, we hear of the plight of the prophet Amos. He never wanted to be a prophet, but he answered God's call. Yet, for preaching God's Word, he get's thrown out of town and is told never to come back!

Wait, wait, there's more! In the Gospel, Jesus gives the disciples - simple fishermen - a mission to do the prophetic work of building the kingdom. Ill-equipped and poorly-prepared for this ministry, they experience rejection and a lack of hospitality!

But where sin abounds, God's grace abounds all the more! That's the Good News we proclaim! For those who heed the message of God's prophets, new life abounds: demons are driven out, the sick are cured, and the Kingdom of God is manifest.

By virtue of our baptism, we too share in the prophetic work of Christ: living as God's beloved and proclaiming God's truth in all we say and do.

May our lives bear help to manifest God's kingdom. May our word and our actions bring Good News to others!
