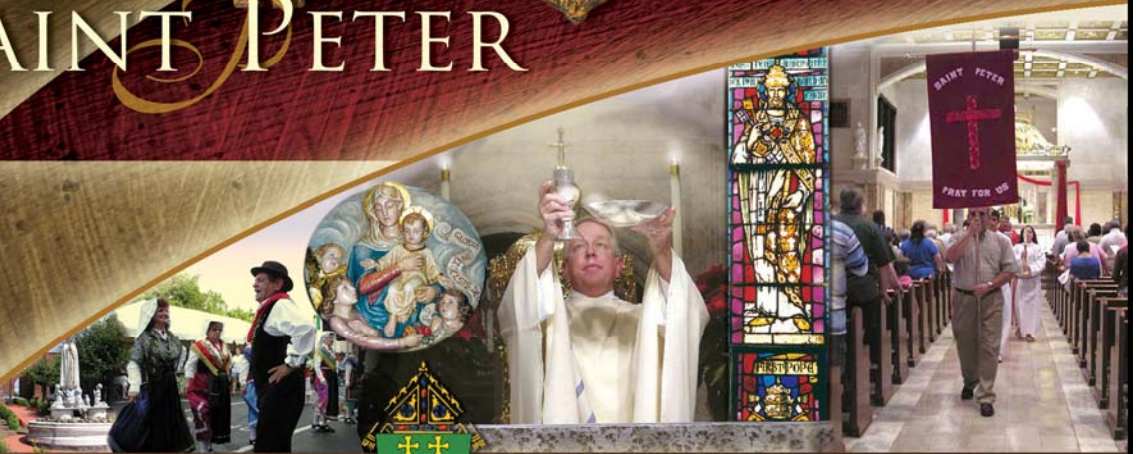
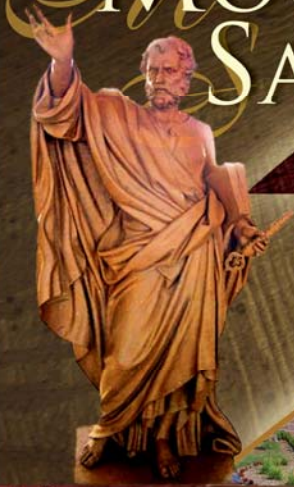

**Anointing of the Sick**

The sacrament of anointing is a celebration of God's healing love for those Christians whose health is seriously impaired by sickness or old age. Anointing may be celebrated in the home, in a hospital, a care facility, or in church.

Through the sacrament of anointing, the Church supports the sick in their struggle against illness and continues Christ's messianic work of healing. All who are united in the bond of a common baptism and a common faith are joined together in the Body of Christ since what happens to one member affects all. The sacrament of anointing effectively expresses the share that each one has in the sufferings of others.

Because of its very nature as a sign, the sacrament of the anointing of the sick should be celebrated with members of the family and other representatives of the Christian community. Then the sacrament is seen for what it is - a part of the prayer of the Church and an encounter with the Lord.

The two most important external actions of the sacrament are the laying on of hands and the anointing with oil. The laying on of hands is a blessing prayer for healing and strength. It is also a prayer of invocation; calling the Holy Spirit upon the sick person. It is also the biblical gesture of healing that Jesus so often used. The anointing with oil is also a biblical gesture that signifies healing, strengthening, and the presence, power and grace of the Holy Spirit.

**As a parish, we will celebrate the sacrament of anointing of the sick within Mass on Saturday, October 17 at 12:00 Noon.**

All are welcome to attend the Mass.



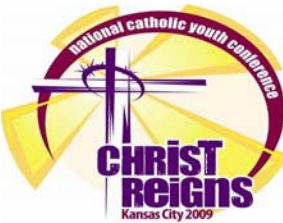


## Youth Ministry

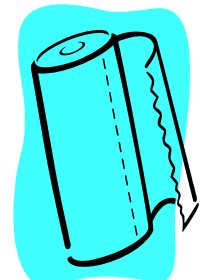

### Paper Product Drive October 31/November 1

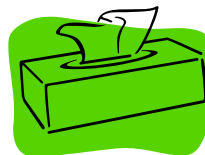
