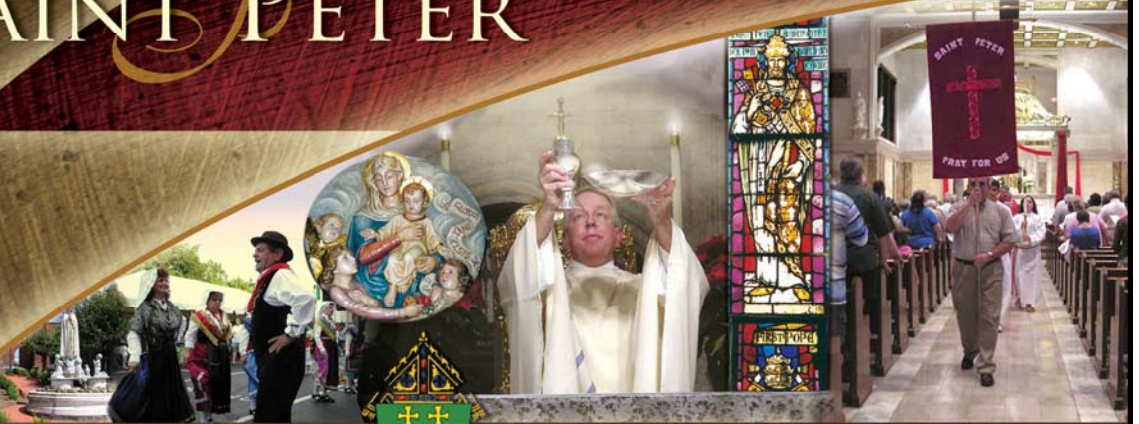
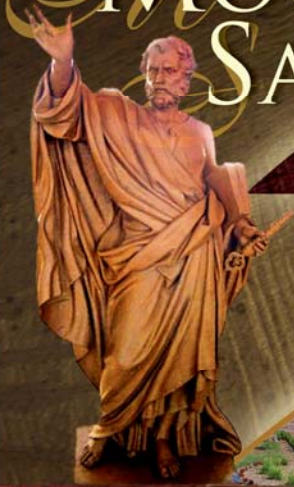

## Pentecost

Come Holy Spirit that we may be aware:

- aware of the people around us, especially the poor and oppressed;
- aware of the children, the young people, and all the people striving to grow into their dignity as beloved children of God;
- aware of the world around us, especially the environment with its plants and animals, with its land and water, with its air and space, with all its mystery;
- aware of all the possibilities for freedom and joy and fullness of life.

Come Holy Spirit. Come!

Fill the hearts of your people.

Give us the wisdom to see.

Give us the courage to speak.

Give us wonder and awe to delight in your love both now and forever.

Amen.

#### Festa 2010 Volunteer Recruitment

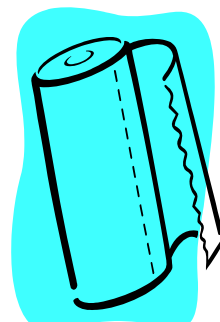

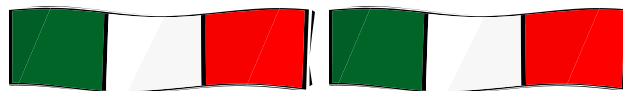
**Junior Youth**
