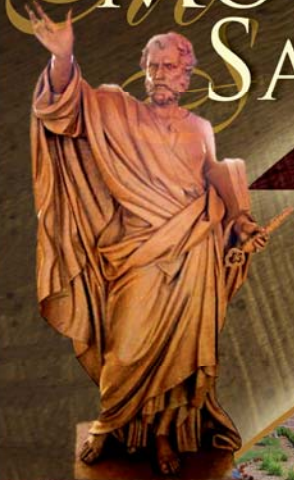

**Peter and Paul, Apostles**

This Tuesday, June 29, we keep a festival in honor of the two apostles who began the harvest of God's reign. They preached from Jerusalem to Rome, keeping the Easter commandment to bring the good news to the ends of the earth.

The church has kept this festival since the 3rd century, honoring Saints Peter and Paul, who were put to death during the fierce persecution under Nero. Peter and Paul are linked in liturgy, art and preaching. It is as if the church in every generation finds encouragement in this partnership of two great apostles: a relationship that should not have worked out, but that in Christ formed the foundation of a worldwide communion. Traditionally, Peter represents the institutional dimension of the church; Paul, the Spirit-inspired, charismatic side.

May the example of these two great apostles inspire us to work together as we build up God's kingdom in our midst!

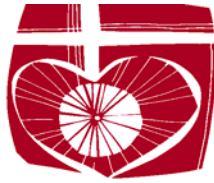
*Faithful and ever-living God,

### Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's scriptures teach that there is no part-time discipleship. Our commitment must be wholehearted and complete. We must have a willing attitude that frees us interiorly from all other concerns so we might be able to follow Christ regardless of our state in life or our occupation.

This attitude of commitment comes not merely from our own generosity of heart but also from our having been transformed into Christ through faith and baptism. Such wholehearted commitment must be an interior reality, not merely an exterior demonstration. It is not for the few; it is required of all.

### Second Collection This Weekend

Today we support the Holy Father in his charitable works. The Peter's Pence Collection is taken up worldwide in an effort of solidarity to support the most disadvantaged: victims of war, oppression and natural disaster and others in need of emergency assistance. Pope Benedict XVI has said, "God's love...gives us the courage to continue seeking and working for the benefit of all". Cast the love of Christ upon the world - please be generous in today's collection.

### Holy Leisure

In the stories of the desert fathers and mothers, the tale is told of a pilgrim who came upon the renowned ascetic Abba Anthony and his disciples playing whatever form of ball one played in the fourth-century Egyptian desert. The pilgrim was scandalized that such holy recluses should cavort in such an undignified way. Anthony suggested that the man take his bow, thread an arrow in it, and pull the string back as far as he could. The man did so. Anthony urged him to pull the string tighter and tighter. Finally, the pilgrim exclaimed, "If I pull the string too tight, it will snap." "Ah," replied Abba Anthony, "just so! And so will the souls of the pious snap if pulled too tight and never allowed to relax." Be sure to take some time this summer to relax and enjoy God's gift of holy leisure!

### Infant Baptism

Before the infant is baptized with the waters of Baptism, parents, Godparents and parishioners profess their faith. This is a significant moment for all of us. For at that time, we are asked to remember and profess, again, what we believe in. *"Whoever says 'I believe' says 'I pledge myself to what we believe.' Communion in faith needs a common language of faith, normative for all and uniting all in the same confession of faith."* (Catechism of Catholic Church) When was the last time you pondered these words - this profession of our faith? 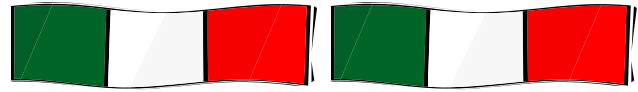


**COMING SOON! PEACE CAMP JULY 12 - 16,**
